The CCNSG Safety Passport course is a nationally recognised qualification which has been designed to offer mandatory and essential basic knowledge to personnel who work on construction and engineering sites. This 2 day course will cover a variety of topics to enable contractors to improve health, safety and environmental awareness.

TARGET GROUP

Many companies require personnel to have completed this course prior to accessing a site or premises. In addition, in order to hold or renew an ECITB ACE card all holders must hold a valid CCNSG card.

CERTIFICATION

Upon successful completion of this course all candidates will be issued with a 6 month temporary CCNSG safety passport on the day, prior to receiving their full card in the post. This card is valid for 3 years, after which candidates must sit the 1 day renewal course.
