

CPCS A62 CRANE/LIFT SUPERVISOR



COURSE OUTLINE

The aim of this course is to provide candidates with underpinning knowledge in order for them to understand the role and responsibility of the Crane Supervisor. Following successful completion of the course candidates will be able to understand and follow safe systems of work for lifting operations including writing risk assessments and method statements.

- Preparing a lift site in accordance with the AP's safe system of work (end test)

TARGET GROUP

This course is aimed at anyone who is required to supervise safe systems of work using lifting equipment. It is recommended that prior to attending this course individuals should have some experience of working with lifting equipment, especially mobile cranes.

CERTIFICATION

Successful candidates will be awarded a Red CPCS Trained Operator card endorsed with the category Crane/Lift Supervisor. Please note the Red CPCS card is only valid for 2 years, within this time you must complete your NVQ Level 4 Diploma to convert from Red card to Blue card. The Blue CPCS card is valid for 5 years and a discount of 20% is offered on NVQ's to all our clients who complete their CPCS training & testing with ourselves.

All candidates attending this course must have passed their CITB Health, Safety & Environment test for Specialist Supervisors within the previous 2 years.
